



Visiting the Cardinal Ambrozic Houses of Providence

At Providence Healthcare, we recognize that family and friends play an important role in the lives of residents. We welcome family and friends 24/7 according to the wishes of our residents.

Please respect the following guidelines **at all times** when visiting a resident:

- The number of people welcomed at any one time is best decided in agreement with the resident and the healthcare team as well as with the other resident in a shared room.
- The size of the room may limit the number of family and friends who can visit at one time. Speak with staff about alternate visiting locations.
- We may need to limit visits or ask you to leave the room for a short period of time to protect the safety, privacy or rights of other residents.
- Children must be supervised by an adult other than the resident.
- Visitors must sign the Visitor Log Book upon arrival, and sign out upon completion of their visit.
- Do not visit if you have symptoms of a cold or flu-like illness, an undiagnosed skin rash, nausea, vomiting and/or diarrhea.

After Hours Visiting

- Quiet Time is between 8:30 p.m. and 7 a.m. Please keep your voices low to respect the needs of residents trying to rest.
- Visitors arriving between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m. must buzz the intercom and identify themselves and the resident they are visiting. Security will notify the nurse in charge of your presence.
- Visitors during these hours must obtain a Visitor Sticker and ensure it is visible at all times.
- To exit the Houses between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m., dial "0" to have security buzz you out.
