



Visiting Providence Hospital

At Providence Healthcare, we recognize that family and friends play an important role in the lives of our patients. We welcome family and friends 24/7 according to the wishes of our patients.

Please respect the following guidelines when visiting a patient:

- The number of people welcomed at any one time is best decided in agreement with the patient and the healthcare team as well as with other patients in a shared room.
- The size of the room may limit the number of family and friends who can visit at one time. Speak with staff about alternate visiting locations.
- We may need to limit visits or ask you to leave the room for a short period of time to protect the safety, privacy or rights of other patients.
- Children must be supervised by an adult other than the patient.
- Quiet Time is between 8:30 p.m. and 7 a.m. Please keep your voices low to respect the needs of patients trying to rest.
- Visitors arriving between 8:30 p.m. and 7 a.m. must register at Reception, located at the Hospital Main Entrance. Your visitor sticker should be visible at all times.
- Do not visit if you have symptoms of a cold or flu-like illness, an undiagnosed skin rash, nausea, vomiting and/or diarrhea.
